
Special Arrangements for ISORA boats arriving in Douglas:

The Sea Cadets Isle of Man have prepared a great weekend for ISORA participants in Douglas:

- Warm welcome on arrival on Saturday morning 23rd May from 01.30 onwards.
- Call Finisher on VHF Channel 6 first 10 min before and then when passing between Green Fairway buoy and Breakwater Red.
- Call Douglas Harbour on VHF CH12, 15 min before arrival and ask permission to enter. If it is not granted go through finish line and turn to Starboard and wait in the bay.
- Once in the outer harbour proceed towards the bridge which will only open at: 0115, 0145, 0215, 0245, 0315, 0345, 0415, 0445, 0515.
- Wait for bridge 100m-300m in front either drifting or secured to starboard wall.
- Once through the bridge, ISORA boats will be rafting on in the starboard side of the basin. Listen to Sea Cadets instructions on Ch6 and visual signs from berthing parties.
- Bridge access to inner Harbour will occur between 01.15 and 05.15 Saturday morning. Those boats not making the bridge lift can tie up at the Visitor's pontoon.
- <u>There will be complimentary warm food for every crew member served in Douglas Bay Yacht</u> <u>Club, which will stay open through the night.</u>



- There will be "Welcome Pack" for every boat with information regarding "facilities and opportunities".
- There will be mini bus service to bring crew to the club. Mini bus will be for boats "parked" behind the bridge and those at the visitor's pontoon.
- **<u>VHF Channel 6</u>** is for communication with Sea Cadets who will be marshalling all boats etc..
- Big screen with Yellow Brick display in the Yacht Club and in the Sea Cadets Mobile HQ for participants to monitor.
- Saturday 23rd BBQ in the Douglas Bay Yacht Club from 1900 <u>£ 5 per person</u>. Prize Giving for boats who successfully arrived at Douglas This might not necessarily be for best sailing result and is sponsored and therefore awarded by Sea Cadets Isle of Man categories will be announced on the night. This will be a great get together for the fleet.
- Sunday 24th 0545 last Bridge lift to start at 06.30 Farewell by Sea Cadets 0630 Start to Dun Laoghaire leg race.
- Berthing in Douglas will be free of charge for ISORA boats
